Located adjacent to The Ohio State University and the dynamic urban retail environment surrounding the campus





- 225,000 square feet of dynamic retail space
- 1200 space parking garage on site
- · 184 residential units
- 8 screen Gateway Film Center
- **50,000 square foot University Bookstore**, home of BARNES & NOBLE
- **58,000 students** at The Ohio State University
- 30,000 faculty and staff work at The Ohio State University
- **57,000 vehicles** pass by the site daily
- 9000 pedestrians pass by per day
- 600 office workers in the project

A 7 acre, 500 unit, residential development is being constructed directly south of Gateway. 300 units opened in 2016 with the remaining units scheduled to open in the Fall of 2017.
