INNOVATION IN EXPERIENCED-BASED RETAIL

4 MILLION SQUARE FEET

Lake Nona Town Center is redefining the retail experience with a variety of destination-worthy shopping, dining, and entertainment options.

The 100-acre experiential magnet is home to two Class-A office buildings, dual-branded Marriott hotel, men's and women's barbershop and salon, multi-level parking structure, and eclectic list of food and beverage tenants including Bosphorous Turkish Cuisine, Chroma Modern Bar + Kitchen, Park Pizza & Brewing Co., and Central Florida's first outdoor food hall built from repurposed shipping containers – Boxi Park. The Town Center's vibrant energy, creativity, and activity are defined by iconic community art pieces and reflected in a robust events program that engages visitors and makes their experience memorable.

Plans for a new 239-room full-service modern hotel, state-of-the-art fitness facility, and Cinèpolis luxury movie theatre have already been announced. At full buildout, Lake Nona Town Center will include more than 80 specialty retailers, anchors, junior anchors, and restaurants making it an unparalleled destination for Lake Nona's nearly 5 million annual visitors.


